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Dear Parents/Guardians and Members of the Cranford community:

I write now to inform you that on May 29, 2018, the New Jersey Department of Education notified Dr. Scott Rubin, our superintendent of schools, of Cranford's "District and School Grade Report" for the 2016-17 school year. That report is posted on the opening page of the Cranford website under "Latest News."

It may also be accessed by clicking (in turn) on the opening page's "District Information" tab, and then on the "Harassment, Intimidation, and Bullying Grade" tab.

In either place when you click on the link for the NJDOE Grade Report be sure to use the "+" key at the top of the document to increase the font size to "100%." This will permit you to read the scores more easily, scrolling across so you may see the grades for your child's school under each column.

If your child is enrolled in one of the programs at Lincoln School (i.e., CAP, CAMP, or LEAP) please look at the scores for Hillside Avenue School (CAMP & LEAP students) and Cranford High School (CAP students) to know the grades for those programs.

Please review these results at your convenience, sharing any questions or concerns you may have about your child's school with either the principal or any member of the school's School Safety Team, including your school's anti-bullying specialist.

Please know that the district's schools are in the process of completing their self-assessments for the current school year that ends next week. These results will be posted during the 2018-19 school year.
