

# Rationale

- Longer instructional periods =
  - Better understanding
  - Higher level of student engagement
  - College like atmosphere
- Less transition time =
  - More instructional time
  - Smoother transitions
  - In depth pedagogical practices

# Rationale

- Time management skill development =
  - "Real" world skill building
  - Improved organizational skills
  - Increase task resolution skills
- Labs no longer are pull out =
  - Increase instructional time in elective classes
  - Improve healthy habits through physical education

# Open Campus

- 1. Evaluated for improvements/adjustments on an annual basis.
- 2. Can be closed by the principal/designee at any time.
- 3. Approved by CHS Administration after student meeting
- 4. Approved by Superintendent after student letter and meeting
- Approved by Board of Education after student discussion and meeting
- 6. Students must obtain "good standing"
- 7. Parents must sign off
- 8. Students receive open campus card

#### Timeline: December 12, 2016-September 2017

- Focus on professional development through Meaningful Mondays and half day professional time
- Distribute materials for edification
- Hold parent information nights
- Conduct student assemblies
- Continue to meet with teachers, administrators and staff to foster a smooth transition
